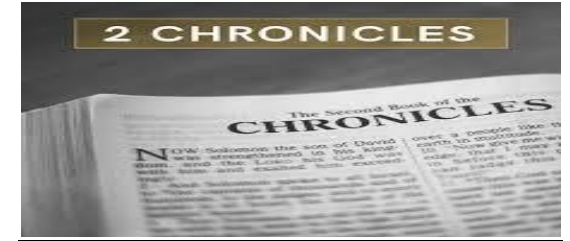
SENTENCE SERMONS
